"CreaDream Forum in Libraries"



This is not the usual handbook that takes you through the project planning, realization and evaluation stages step by step. We offer the chance to get acquainted with the activities of Valmiera Library project "CreaDream Forum in Libraries" that were carried out as part of NORDPLUS Adult Program in cooperation with Valmiera Zonta Club, Turku Library, Turku Women's Center and the Tallinn Central library. This handbook follows the course of the project highlighting the methods that allowed it to become so successful.









The aim of the project- to promote the understanding of contemporary culture in society.

Our task was to implement unconventional, inspiring Lifelong Learning Programme in the library in order to encourage the local community to acquire skills that help to face the challenges of today's society.

Motto-Understand the spirit of the time and take advantage of opportunities

Nowadays, people are confused. The world and society is changing due to many reasons - technology, media and social processes. Options have multiplied and a wise selection in this information and goods chaos seems difficult. This requires new skills and understanding.

The project was aimed at ensuring that the library with its partners helps people understand the processes of today's society and see their surroundings and life situations as comprehensible, manageable and meaningful set of actions. With such a vision, they should be able to act confident in their own interest and for the good of community.



Why should new skills be acquired in library?

The library is open to information and training, it is a place where to find inspiration and to discover new worlds. Public libraries provide the physical space for both large and small communities and give an opportunity to acquire new knowledge, new experiences and emotions in a democratic and secure environment. It is a source of joy, friendship and multiculturalism.





Two partner meetings were held in Turku and Tallinn to develop ideas during the project preparation. At this stage it was important to

- Advance cooperation between project participants
- Bring closer NGO's and public libraries

 Explore ways to inspire people in the communities to a positive attitude acquiring new skills. To assume responsibility for their own development of competencies.



A network of partners was established. Common and local targets were defined and a project application was prepared and submitted to Nordplus Adult program. The project was supported and initiated in September 2015. 20 499 EUR were granted for project implementation.

How to get to creative ideas?



One of the benefits of international cooperation is the ability to exit the usual circle of contacts and, consequently, the usual way of thinking. This is certainly a positive impact on creative ideas and allows to look at the problem from a new perspective.

Everyone tends to get stuck in certain thinking patterns. Breach of these templates can get new ideas.





Sometimes it seems that the best ideas come by chance - seeing and hearing something completely unrelated to the situation you are trying to solve. **Why does this happen?** Accidental element provides new impetus and makes our brain cells become active. You can use this principle consciously trying to combine incompatible.



Few methods for looking at a problem from a new perspective:

- Use random words: select a word from a dictionary and look for the link between this word and your problem.
- Create a mind map of ideas: Enter a keyword or phrase in the middle of a page. Continue writing around it everything else that comes to mind in connection with this idea. See what links between these can be formed.

- Use a picture. Prepare different picture cards (Postcards, beautiful images or other inspirational, beautiful pictures), pull out one image and invent a story on how the image can be linked to your situation.
- Involve random items. Ask yourself questions, for example, "How can this object help solve the problem?" or "What are the properties of this object that could help us solve the problem?"

On Cooperation and Conflict

There is an interesting theory called "Onion model". Its states that in negotiation and cooperation one must take into consideration that people do not always directly express their needs, especially if it is a conflict, or a new and uncertain situation.

During negotiations where partners are not yet well acquainted and do not know if they can trust each other, people can hide their real needs and take up some position instead. This position is a certain impression the person wants to leave. Unfortunately, if this happens, the negotiation won't provide a long term solution as it wont be based on meeting everyone's needs. Each position is based on particular interests- reasons why a person choses a particular position. But these interests not always reveal ones real needs.

This model aims to point out the need to try to get through the upper layers and to focus on the real needs. When you express your needs openly it will encourage others to do the same.

If all parties during negations openly discuss what is important to each party, what are the concerns and desires that motivate them, then instead of having to discuss each of their positions, you start to discuss various options on how to implement your needs.

Your goal is to reach a mutually acceptable agreement. As in any situation partners will have both compatible and conflicting interests. It is always more than one acceptable solution to a problem.

The course of the project

Valmiera Library Project target groups:

O A wide audience - Participate in intellectual cafes, attend public lectures, afterwards discuss and share thoughts and experiences.



20 socially active women (Valmiera Zonta Club members, businesswoman, charitable association activist) who participate in the project as cooperation partners. These women are involved in implementation of the educational program, acquire practical skills and provide evaluation of project activities.



O 10 Valmiera Library Adult Department librarians who realized the project activities as moderators, thus improving their personal and professional skills, overcoming themselves and strengthening mutual cooperation.



Project task - to learn the topic - contemporary society, art, music, literature, view of the world. To be achieved through educational programs and theories and practical exercises.

- "Learning by doing" practical workshops for target group (30 socially active woman and librarians) on contemporary skill acquisition and application.



First reflections



Conclusions from Moderator Anita notes:

- «We didn't make it! Should I involve another colleague? Yes, definitely!» /About updating information on website, Twitter and Facebook two days before the event/
- "The space needs to be organized 2- 2.5 h before the event!" With the aim that half an hour before the start everything is set in its place: chairs, technology is set up, guest speaker is having a coffee and singing contract.
- Nuisance nr 1. Don't imagine that the rest of the world knows everything about your amazing event. Not at all! You need to inform everyone, even remotely involved, about the plan of the event and how it will affect their work.
- Cleaning up. After the event take a break. Start cleaning up and putting away the chairs only after the last visitor has left.
- Nuisance Nr 2. A responsible person for the After party in museum should have been appointed. This should have been completely left in this person's hands. On the day of the event moderator does not have any time for anything else apart from the lecturer- from arrival till goodbyes. This means everything that is left unfinished remains unfinished. If no one is appointed to greet the guests, no one will do it etc. The same goes for taking photos, arranging extra chairs, setting up technology etc. This is what our great team is for and the moderator/ assistant has to rely on them.
- Conclusion about the space. "Don't leave" the library if not absolutely necessary. Any change of venue is time and resource intensive. The choice of having the event in the museum was great but WAS IT REALLY NECESSARY?



Conclusions from Moderator Assistant's Liga notes:

- Don't leave anything to the last moment
- Everything takes more time than planned
- Clear delegation of tasks between the team members
- O Don't take on too much: delegate in advance. As our Finish colleague Raija has said: "You need to ask for help as people really want to help. Its human nature. You just need to ask!"

Conclusions about the team

- Very active, united
- We felt positive support
- No dramatic mistakes were made
- We had few mishaps that were resolved on the spot /logistics of snacks, chasing some potential guests for the after party/
- Everything worked out after all!
- Thanks to everyone we worked as a TEAM





Here are the results from the question after the lecture: "Did you get wiser on the matter of today's society?" The event had 45 participants, 35 of those submitted their responses and 33 of these were "Yes".



P.S. I think we can similarly evaluate the first event. We really enjoyed some of it, some of it touched us deeply and we can not deny the joy we were feeling after the event.



Supervision



Today, on December 1st 2015, we started **SUPERVISION** workshops as part of the Creadream project.

- Sessions are run by Anita Ozolina. She has a master's degree in Public Administration and Hamburg / Riga / Gestalt Institute Certificate on Supervisor qualifications and extensive experience in both social work and supervision management.
- Supervision is so-called support training for people who work with people in the so-called helping professions. Supervision is a consultative assistance on matters relating to work and professional activity. Professional efficiency is supervisions main result, which may include a variety of issues: awareness of professional boundaries, finding alternative actions in specific work situations, establishing relationship with colleagues, subordinates, customers, team co-operation, working strategies, reduction of stress factors and burnout and many other questions that are important for daily work.

During our 2 sessions and 6 hours we will gain an insight in Supervision and useful knowledge for ourselves

Notes from first Supervision workshop, December 2015

 Supervision is minds hygiene; only professional matters are discussed. Everyone needs body, mind and spiritual hygiene.

Its important that person who works with people, has joy in their hearts.

There are teams/ collectives where its acceptable to make mistakes and there are those were its not. Thinking rational, we should avoid creating atmosphere based on fear.

Clients don't need to be handled... Its important to do as much as possible in any given situation.

"The strength of cobra is based on rabbits' fear"

It pays off to show your cards.

Let (support) your charge (student, subordinate) to outgrow you- it's a talent

The best tactic for teamwork- my strengths are these, but for these I will need that not everyone has. your help. The best teams are formed from different personalities.

Nothing is right and nothing is wrong!

Each characteristic has an opposite that also has a remarkable role in specific situation. E.g. hard working, active (+)- lazy, slow (-). Is "doing nothing"- mediation, reflection- laziness with plus or minus?

Every now and then one needs to review his strengths and ask a question: Haven't I glorified myself with too much pride in my strengths?

These are powerful nails that often follow us from childhood: you are the oldest; you are sensible and patient; everything comes easily fro you etc. The same goes for negatives: you are so slow etc.

Its important to experience polarity of one's characteristics and emotions.

Healthy life is balanced. Its normal to cross borders on occasion. Its important to balance it back and don't stay in the wrong position.



Supervision workshop 2:

Scribbled notes from second workshop

- Every now and then the "soul pillows" need airing!
- Quote from Paul Coelho "Maktub": "We are so rushed that we don't completely understand what we are doing. So now we have to wait for the souls we missed on the way" (perfect example of mindfulness practise)
- We can lift human soul with small signs of attention
- Where is aggression coming from?
- When raising children (admonishing them), we often put them down. This causes resistance which is a natural order of things. We do everything to crush the resistance and that lowers the child even more which brings even greater resistance and martial amplitude. Adult trying to preserve the authority and the right to say the last word, the child the right to their views, the right to be heard and understood, finally to preserve natural self-esteem (if it has not already been "defeated"). Further in life these reduced souls are trying to solve all their problems through conflict. They live offended. When they desire something, they need a lot of courage. They already know that they will be rejected.
- This might be a useful phrase when addressing aggressive person (peacefully and without stress): "Listen! I don't like being talked to in a rude manner. I'm treating you with respect..." EVERYONE WANTS TO BE VALUED, IMPORANTNT AND ACCEPTED. I UNDERSTADN YOU. This is the key to resolve even the most complicated situations.
- We must learn to recognize, accept and heal our injuries. Look for someone to talk to in order to heal them. It is important to be aware of where lives your rejections pain. The good news: if we recognize and accept - we are half-healed.
- Rejection misleads us in thinking that we are failures and worse than others. NOT TRUE!
- Respect others for what they have already accomplished even if they are not aware of it themselves.
- It is better to say "thank you for your patience!" instead of "sorry, I'm always late!"

Bārbala Simsone, literary scientist and critic, during the first part of the evening gave a lecture - a study on "Monsters and metaphors. Insight into the world of horror literature." After a short coffee break, the second part of the event - a meeting with one of the most interesting contemporary Latvian middle generation writers Nora Ikstena and her co-operation partners, the publishing house "Dienas Gramata" manager Dace Sparāne-Freimane Talking about the book "Mother's Milk".

Bārbala Simsone theme organically blended with Nora Ikstena novels main characters' fates. If initially it seemed that the themes are rather different from one another, then the end resulted in a single common denominator. Reality experience through the author's courage to open up becomes the reason for reader's ametional experience.







































Conversation about modern view of the world through ancient scripts. 12.04.2016.



Fifth public lecture

Lecturer and moderator-translator and poet Uldis Bērziņš.

Event in 2 parts: he first part is devoted to the main religious text of Islam (Islamic scriptures) "Quran" the second part – ancient Icelandic mythological and poetic text collection "Songs of Edda."

During the conversation Uldis Berzins touches "the Quran" importance and topicality in contemporary society. Translator also spoke about the translation process and the difficult situations faced during the translation process. Uldis Berzins spent more than 10 years translating "Quaran" from the Arabic language. He has also made the ancient texts of "Songs of Edda" available in Latvian. The translation of "Songs of Edda" was not an easy task, given the large distances in space and time that separates us from the "Edda" voices.

Workshop with philosophical artist Maris Subacs

We do not understand the time we live in, and later it illuminates and clarifies. God's spirit-invisible reality, an alloy that can not be seen and the artist tires to disclose this vision.



Two drawing techniques:


<u>To draw problems, to pronounce them in drawing, to visualize</u>
<u>"everything is fine with me".</u> Black and white colors (heavy-bodied, two brushes – for each color its own and two water bowls.) Drawing applied on white sheet, preferably offset carton. Acrylic paint dries and is insoluble in water.



Relax, free your mind from thoughts. Start with black paint, allowing your hand to sketch the drawing itself. It doesn't matter what is forming on the paper. Do everything slowly. Stop and look at the drawing from aside. Then take the white color, and corrects (paint over) parts of drawing that are not satisfactory for your inner senses. Thus, alternately changing colors, draw and watch your feelings. You can put work aside for a while and come back to continue until you have inner peace.

The method can help to deal with internal anxiety. This does not mean that the problem is resolved in reality, but your attitude towards it changes, and sometimes this is enough.

Workshop continues:



Draw with markers on white paper, thinking- God leads me. No special sense of God is necessary. Relax. Draw allowing your hand to move freely, draw the lines strongly, maybe a story rises in consciousness. When the drawing is completed you do not need to study it. Put it away and forget about it.



Final conclusions



Project task has materializedcontemporary knowledge capacity building for local community and target group.

- O The original intention of the project has materialized: almost 300 people from Valmiera have attended five high-quality content lectures for public, related to modern society, contemporary art, music, literature, modern worldview processes. Target group's (50+) 20 participants have gained more knowledge about themselves and others, with the participation in Supervision workshops. The participants gained knowledge of application of new technologies: social networks (Facebook), IT and modern reading (e-books), modern photography and IT.
- Outcome of the project: interesting encounters, valuable insights, open thinking.

Project- well attended events and intensive workshops

- During the project, Valmiera library adult department has become a good team for event organization and built stronger relationship among themselves, because each employee several times during the project had to become event moderator or assistant moderator with the relevant obligations. The beginning was not so easy as just a few of employees had done something similar previously. Everyone had to overcome internal scepticism and uncertainty. However, now that we have jointly created events for several months, we are very pleased with the progress made.
- The unique part of the project is the search for new ways to cooperate with customers. By joint planning and implementation of project activities, we have expanded the boundaries of understanding of customer participation in the library services. A year long new adventure of knowledge for librarians and socially active woman from local community gave opportunity to create new contacts and have cross-sectorial experience exchange. The circle of library's friends was expanded.

Project banner successfully fulfilled its functions for more than half a year: to inform, to remind and to look good in the background.
